One learner from each phase will be awarded the scholarship which will cover tuition. The successful applicant will receive a scholarship dependant on the examination results.

B	Very Good Academic achievement (85%+ average) at an acceptable academic standard AND based performance in the scholarship examinations.	The Scholarship percentage determined by the Headmaster and School board will account for partial school/tuition fees. This does not include other extras like fees for boarding, equipment or textbooks, levy, insurance and external examination fees.
C	Very Good Academic achievement (80%+ average) at an acceptable academic standard AND based performance in the scholarship examinations.	The Scholarship percentage determined by the Headmaster and School board will account for partial school/tuition fees. This does not include other extras like fees for boarding, equipment or textbooks, levy, insurance and external examination fees.
D	Good academic achievement (60% average) at an acceptable standard, consideration of all round performance, including sport, extra murals i.e. music AND based performance in in the scholarship examinations.	The Scholarship percentage determined by the Headmaster and School board will account for partial school/tuition fees. This does not include other extras like fees for boarding, equipment or textbooks, levy, insurance and external examination fees.
